

There are categories and filters.

The categories give you a first overview. For example, if you like sports, take a look at the "Sports & Games" category.



If you want to discover Hamburg, the "Adventure & Discoveries" category is perfect for you.

If you would like to go on a trip with

your family, take a

look at the category "Hamburg's surrounding area".

If you would like to go on a trip without your parents, click through the "Trips" category.

You can use the filters to narrow down the search results further.

You can search for courses for your age group and for those that take place in your area

("Offers in your district" or "Postcode"). You can search for offers during a specific period, such as only during the



summer holidays, or on a specific day.
You can also filter for offers that can be paid via the Bildungspaket (education package).
Another search will show you offers that can also be used by children and adolescents in wheelchairs.

Use the "Offers for rainy days" filter to find events that are fun even if the weather is bad in Hamburg, which you can go to spontaneously without registering in advance.

If you are a girl and only want to spend your holiday with other girls, tick the "Offers for girls only" filter.

If you already know what you want to search for, use the "Search all courses" field. Simply



enter your
search term,
for example
"chess". Then
you will find
all chess
courses.

Using the filters, search function and categories, it's easy to narrow down the many Holiday Pass offers and find the right events for you.


